\$20,000 PRIZE POOL

- The Tournament will be played subject to the Rules of Snooker as prescribed by the WPBSA.
- ABSC Playing Conditions and all matters pertaining to Player's Code of Conduct and Ethics will also be
 adhered to. Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary
 action being taken against the offenders.
- Players or referees are not permitted to smoke/vape or consume alcohol whilst involved in a game.
- Players must be financial members of their Affiliate State or National Federation and in good standing.
- The first games on Friday and Saturday mornings will have official referees.. Losing players of each game thereafter will be required to referee the next game on the match table they have just played on. If players choose not to referee, a \$30 fee is applicable and be paid to the Tournament Director.
- The players in the Consolation Plate will referee their own games.
- Official referees will be made available from the Last 16 onwards.
- Dress code shall be SNOOKER state/association/club polo shirts with dark dress trousers and dark fully enclosed dress shoes during play on Friday and Saturday as well as the Consolation Plate. All players from Final-16 on Sunday will be full dress code with vest and bow tie and as set out by the ABSC. Anyone requiring a deviation to these dress codes shall supply a doctor's certificate to the Tournament Director at the time of the entry closing date.
- Format:
 - Play to commence at 9.00 am on Friday, 2 August 2024.
 - All matches in the main event are best of 5 with the final being best of 7.
 - Play will continue Saturday, 3 August 2024, from 9:00am, until the Final-16 players are determined.
 - The Final-16 of the main event will be played on Sunday, 4 August 2024 commencing at 9.00am sharp.
- Consolation Plate
 - Entry fee for the Consolation Plate is \$20
 - All mobile phone numbers must be submitted when entering. SnookerStat will be used for the Consolidation Plate draw and each player will receive a text message 5 minutes prior to their game.
 - The first games of the Consolation Plate will not commence before 12pm on Saturday.
 - The Consolation Plate games shall be best of 3. Each frame shall be played with 10 reds and if players require more than 2 snookers after all reds are potted, the player behind in points must concede.
 - The Consolation Plate Final shall be best of 5 only if time permits.
- Prize money will be paid in cash up to a limit of \$1,000.00, and any balance owing will be transferred to the player's bank accounts by the Club on Monday, 5 August 2024.
- A completed entry form and entry fee will be required before any player is permitted to compete.
- If players wish to bring a guest to the Tournament Dinner, please add this to the entry form and pay an additional fee of \$60 per guest. Please note that the Tournament Dinner is included in each player's entry fee.
- Tournament Director may vary T&Cs if needed.
- This entry form constitutes part of the conditions of entry.
- Indemnity & Acknowledgement: All participants enter at their own risk. None of the ABSC, the venue, the sponsors nor the organisers shall be responsible for any loss, injury or misadventure arising.
